## God is For Us

In Romans 8:31, Paul says, “If God be for us, who can be against us?” Yet, sadly, many Christians today struggle with the idea of God being *for* them. They look at their struggle with sin and assume that God must not love them as much as He does others who are “more obedient”. Many Christians think that even if God does love them, He surely can’t *like* them very much. They look at the suffering in their lives and it causes them to come to the conclusion that God is angry with them, or that He is making them

pay for their sins (even though the Bible says that Jesus paid for *all* of their sins). In their minds, God cannot be *for* them, or else life wouldn’t be going the way it is.

Let me give you two quick thoughts to help you if you struggle in this way.

#1) Jesus died for you when you were His enemy. [Romans 5:10] There was nothing good about you then, and He gave tremendous grace to you. Why do you think you have to be “good” to

get any grace from Him now that you are His child?

#2) Suffering is one of God’s major tools to shape us into the image of Jesus. Knowing all this is why we can rejoice in our suffering as Scripture says to. If we know that because of Jesus and our being *in Him* that God is *for us*, we will look at suffering as something that God is using to conform us more and more into the image of Jesus!

Let me say this one more time. Christian, GOD IS FOR YOU!
